We are sinners even If we committed only one sin in our entire lives, and we are therefore guilty not only by inheritance but

personally too! (1John.1:8). We are destined to be without God for eternity, in hell! Unless we make amends in time!

Amazing Grace.

Mercifully, God's love for us is much greater than our sins and ungratefulness. He loves us so much that He did the unthinkable. He sent His beloved, perfect and innocent Son to us as a man, to abide by The Ten Commandments perfectly for us, because we cannot. He came to pay the price for our sins because we cannot save ourselves (1Pet.3:18-)! God's amazing grace for us came into fruition when His Son Jesus Christ, was born on Christmas day. He was the opposite of our human celebrities and rulers. He came without pomp and ceremony. He came to serve, not to be served. He left His loving Father and wonderful kingdom with all it's magnificent comforts behind and He came to suffer pain. hardships, even death to save us! Unbelievably, the only true and loving God did not come to punish us, but to save us! His punishment started immediately. He was born in a barn and was laid down in a smelly crib with animal feed; far from home; in the dead of winter. He was seen as an illegitimate child in a very conservative society. In an attempt to murder Him, the dictator at the time (Herod) murdered all children about His age, and they had to flee to Egypt to escape this. He later grew up in Nazareth, a very poor town. He spent His short (human) life teaching and healing many thousands of people. He washed peoples feet and rode a donkey! He was betrayed by a loved apostle and denied by another. He was seen as a gangster and ridiculed by many people throughout His life and even today, as are His followers! He was arrested and found to be innocent. However, a criminal named Barabbas, was released in His place, and Jesus was tortured and crucified in the most shameful, horrific and painful way possible. Like Barabbas, we are guilty and deserve to be punished, but like Barabbas we can now become free of this punishment! If we accept Jesus our day of judgement can be over and done!

Jesus cured many sick people and He even resurrected people that have already died, even at a distance! He could do this because He is truly God. How much easier would it have been for Him to escape death by simply letting all his enemies perish on the spot? Or He could have simply disappeared from their midst as He has done many times before. But because of his love of the Father, and us, He restrained himself and allowed sinners like us to murder Him, to be slaughtered like a lamb, just to save us! Truly amazing grace!

Because we are all sinners, we are just as guilty as those who physically crucified Jesus. Because of our sins it was necessary for Jesus to die on the cross for us!

In His hour of need on the cross He was abandoned by The Father and was left at the mercy of His greatest enemy; Satan. We cannot even comprehend the full extend of His suffering and hardships there.

Knowing His fate beforehand, He prayed intensely to the Father to let this pass Him by. But He loved the Father and us so much, that He obeyed the Father and submitted Himself to the punishment that we deserve! And the Father loves us so much that He allowed His beloved Son to endure this torture (Rom.8:32;5:8). Would you or me abandon a beloved child and allow him to be subjected to something like this, for something we don't really need? Surely this was painful for the Father too!

Mary may have suspected that this child was going to tear her heart apart. How painful for a mother to see her beloved son suffer so often throughout His life, especially at the end when she had to watch Him die a damned and painful death on a cross, at the tender age of only 32?

At the time there was a sturdy curtain in the temple. Nobody was allowed behind this curtain as that was God's domain only. The only exception was the high priest who could enter once a year to clean up. When Jesus died the earth shook and this curtain tore apart. This symbolises the fact that Jesus has opened the way for us to reach God again! We can get to God without having to be perfect anymore! Our 'good' deeds don't count anymore.

Jesus paid the full price about two thousand years before we were born!

On the third day after His crucifixion Jesus rose from the dead (Luk.24:6) and forty days later He ascended to heaven (Luk24:51), thereby conquering death and paving the way for His followers! So now the ten commandments are no longer intended to be a punishment or a burden for us, but rather to:

- free us from the consequences of sin;
- make us aware of how God wants to be served:
- make us aware of all our sins;
- > make us aware of how much we need Jesus to save us.

It would drastically improve our lives and the lives of those around us if we could comply fully! This is what God wants for us. Only the best!

Jesus did not bring peace on earth, but now we can be at peace with God!

The Lord wants us to come to Him.

We have a responsibility if we want to be with God in His kingdom. We are tested for this and we are not accepted by default. It is different from what we assume, and yet it makes perfect sense! Unfortunately, very few people ever discover this truth (luk.13:22,18:8; Matt.7:13) because they don't seek!

Even brilliant scientists wonder why we are here, but tragically, few really bother to find out. Perhaps they are so absorbed by the complexities and intricacies of nature and science itself that they fail to notice it's Creator! This knowledge is not apparent to most highly educated people, but is revealed to many simple people (Mat.11:25).

We cannot help to earn our salvation by trying to be good because Jesus paid fully and perfectly for our sins and therefore we cannot contribute.

Satan and his demons will not be in heaven and therefore all those who are there will be perfect by default! Therefore, there is no need to be 'good' before we get there! All the false religions originated from Satan, and he tells his followers to be 'good'. He hates us and he does not want us so he demands great sacrifices which enslaves his followers without any benefit to anyone.

God has shown us so many times and so convincingly that He loves us. He wants our love in return. He wants us to believe in Jesus Christ and accept Him as our one and only Saviour (1Joh.5:11; Joh.14:6; and many more...) and to establish a relationship with Him. He wants to be our caring and loving Saviour, and for us to become his loving and trusting bride, child and friend. Our Lord loves us and He wants *us*, not our sacrifices!

It is like a good marriage. If you want to share your life with someone you would firstly seek such a person. If you have found someone you spend time getting to know them. When you are far away you read their letters and emails (the Bible) over and over and phone them often (pray). When you are ready to commit to this relationship you become engaged (baptism, commit your faith). You tell all your friends and relatives about your loving fiancé (Evangelise). If both persons agree to love each other for life it becomes a marriage (eternity with God).

But a relationship cannot exist unless both parties agree to it. God has shown many times how much He wants everyone of us to be in a relationship with Him. God loves us beyond our comprehension and He is sad to see anyone who does not want to be a part of it.

He will let us go if we don't care or don't want to be in this relationship with Him. He has even created His own opposition so that we can have that choice! He sets us free hoping that we will come back to Him of our own free will and because we love Him and we want to be with Him. God allows Satan to try drawing us away from Him. Unless we resist Satan we are lost and we are destined to be without God forever, by default. If we love God we would resist this evil force and God will help us. We have to seek the truth and to get to know and love the one and only true God. This we can do! And this is how we are tested!

The necessity of our relationship is confirmed many times in the Bible and as far back as Exodus 20 by the words "...but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love Me...". Later on Jesus often sent people away with the words ".. I don't know you...". No matter how good i am at anything, i am nothing without love (1Cor.13). The criminal that was crucified next to Jesus was saved by his last words to Jesus (Luk.23:42).

Following His first statement Jesus often said something like: "..away from me all you evildoers". It is true that we are all sinners and evildoers but these people had no relationship with Jesus and therefore their sins were not paid for on the cross. They will still have to face their Day of Judgement.

In Exodus 20 the words "...and keep my commandments." follow the first statement. We will therefore try to keep God's commandments but not to save us. Instead we will do it because we love Him, we want to please Him and we know that He has our best interests at heart. They are intended to improve our lives here as well. If we can abide by them we will be happier as we won't have to suffer the consequences of our deeds, our consciences will be clear, and we will improve the lives of others as well by creating a more caring and loving environment!

Simply believing that Jesus has died for us is not enough. Satan *knows* Jesus very well but it will not save him! Our lives have to change. We need to establish that relationship with the Lord, become reborn (Joh.3:1-8), join His church and participate actively in it, be baptised (Eph.4:5,Act.19:5). and accept the faith. He wants us to care for each other (Heb.10:25,Joh.15:9), praise Him and to bring our offerings to help maintain the church and to support the less fortunate. Spend time and effort with Him and other people, especially those who love Him too.

We have to abandon all other gods (Ex.20:3,23).

The Lord wants us to tell others about Him, so that they also get an opportunity to be saved. God is saddened by those who have not yet found and accepted Him and that is why He wants us to tell to the whole world about Him (Col.4:4; Mat.9:38).

What kind of a person would i be if; knowing how great and loving God is and how much He wants us all to accept Him, and how terrible it would be to spend eternity without Him, and i remained quiet about it? If one person saves another from a temporary disaster he/she is regarded as a hero. How much more of a hero would a person be if he/she saved someone from being with Satan and all his evil ways for ever and to be with God and His loving grace and care for all eternity instead?

Evangelism can be difficult initially. Satan tries to discourage us as much as he can. We have to overcome the fear, the tension, perhaps the stuttering, not finding the right words to say. But if we resist the devil he will run away (James4:7). Then it becomes a wonderful experience telling others about the great love of God for us, and knowing that you are working for God's kingdom; with everlasting results! We get to know our loving God more as we tell. We are no longer spectators but we have sided with the winning team! It is extremely gratifying knowing that God may have used you when you notice a big change in the life of someone you told!

Don't lose heart if you cannot do all these things perfectly. Remember that Jesus sacrificed perfectly for <u>all</u> our sins and imperfections, including these! When we are weak, God's strength shines through!

Satan hates God and us!

Satan is very cruel and neither stupid nor lazy. He is using many techniques to keep us ignorant or to lead us astray, and he is deceiving the vast majority of people. He hates God and each and everyone of us with a passion. He spends all his time and effort to prevent us from finding the one and only true God. He does not want us but he does not want God to have us either. His main focus is to conceal the only way left for us to get back to God namely through Jesus Christ. (Matt.13:19, 2Cor.4:3-4, 1Tes.2:18). He has established all the false religions some of which appear to be good and even mention Jesus, but distorts the truth. He

tries to make us believe anything as long as it excludes Jesus Christ as our one and only saviour. Most people then get confused in their search or just give up and accept fables or whatever feels right to them (Gal.1:6....).

All these false religions treat their followers badly. They have to make many sacrifices and they are punished regularly if they do not comply.

In the eastern countries he dominates the people like slaves. He punishes them harshly if they fail to bring their prescribed offerings of food and drinks. That is why they have so many shrines on the street corners and even in their homes and workplaces. These people live in constant fear of punishment in case their offerings were inadequate. To them these evil spirits are very real and very fearful, and their greatest hope in life is for lots of "good luck" and "a long and happy life". They really are fearful of what awaits them after this life as an ex Buddhist testifies. Glamorous temples can be found even in poor suburbs amongst the most humble shacks proving that satan's demands and burdens are very high on his followers!

In Africa Satan has many people obsessed with the spirits of their forefathers and other evil spirits such as the "tokelosie". They have to perform many painful and deadly rituals.

Satan tells us many lies such as: it is not important to have a relationship with God; we have to be "good" to get to God; there are many ways to get to God; we will get another chance if we fail this time (re-incarnation); we will be okay because we are not really "bad"; the stars somehow affect our "karma"; and many, many more. Through the media he continuously tries to make us believe his fables of evolution and almost all of Europe and the west believe it without question! He does his utmost to prevent us from searching and finding God in time for us to be saved. Even on our death beds he will try to mislead us!

He tries to deceive us into a false sense of security and many do not realise the importance of inviting God into our lives. Many get so absorbed by their studies, work, business and even sports that they neglect the Lord and His church! Many say that they 'do not have the time' when it comes to church matters. Do they actually mean: they are too busy making a living that they do not have time for God? Many church members walk out of a sermon if it runs a little late. Would these same people also walk away when a rugby game goes into injury time? Why do we think that we have to work very hard to succeed in this life but that the everlasting life is not as important and it will just work out fine by itself?

Satan tries to keep us quiet, makes us uncomfortable, stirs our emotions, clouds our minds and makes us think and act irrational when the Gospel and especially Jesus is discussed. This puts a damper on evangelism, which is exactly what he wants to achieve. He wants us to remain silent, uninformed, confused and ignorant, until it is too late.

In order to tease God, Satan encourages people to use the holy name of God and Jesus in vain. Sadly, this blasphemy is now accepted in our society and through the media and it is even highlighted in program previews! Even if they do edit out the f... words they still keep the blasphemy in!

The greatest days on the Christian calendar is Christmas and Easter. On the former Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus on earth. He is also known as 'Immanuel' meaning 'God amongst men'. A very happy occasion when Jesus gave up His heavenly home and came down to man and paid fully for all our sins in order to mend our relationships with God.

However, Satan has distorted Christmas day celebrations into a "Santa" (Satan?) with reindeer and slay bringing gifts to children. Our shops and stores exploit this opportunity to make great financial profits while playing distorted Christmas songs to encourage shoppers to spend more! People wish each other a "merry" (drunken?) Christmas, but the "politically correct" way is to wish people "happy holidays" instead, so as not to offend followers of satan's religions!

On Good Friday the great love of God and Jesus for us reached a climax when Jesus was crucified and punished to fully pay for

our sins. Once again the wonderful truth has been reduced to fables for children about bunnies and Easter eggs!

At an early age children are told these lies, and later in life they view these days as if they really were fairy tales for kids, and they in turn propagate these lies to their kids. Because of this the amazing grace of God is forgotten.

People who consult mediums to contact their ancestors are often convinced that they were in contact with their loved ones. This is not so. All souls belong to God and God does not allow them to be disturbed. But Satan knows us all intimately and he knows exactly what to say to convince that person that they really were in contact with the deceased person because something was said that "only that person would know". The only exception God allowed was when Saul contacted Samuel and the medium got such a fright when he really did appear that she fell off her chair (1Sam.28-)! This has never happened to her before! This is a great sin and Saul was punished for it. He died the next day.

From the book of Job we can see how eager Satan is to harm us (job1:12-20). He will do everything God allows him to do as soon as he is allowed! God has to restrain him continuously to prevent him from turning our lives into absolute misery. But occasionally God will allow something to slip through, usually when we need it for our long term benefit. Perhaps to make us humble again, to build our character or as a wakeup call. Bear in mind; God's priority is not our comfort and convenience here, but our presence forever. Like Job, we cannot always understand why we are experiencing hardships and most often it is not intended as punishment.

We see on the news all the cruel acts Satan instigates and has inspired people and terrorists to do, murders, rapes, robberies, disease, you name it. Take away all the good things that happen in life and this gives us a good insight into what it will be like being with him in hell! Except that he will not be restricted there!

God is not overbearing.

God does not pressure us in any way to influence our decision. He does not try to grab our attention with great marketing strategies or miracles and shows of power. He is Almighty and He could make the stars dance for us, the earth stop or spin the other way, the angels sing us love songs or whatever. To the casual observer God does not appear to be real or desirable.

Jesus was not popular on earth creating much friction with local authorities and He and His disciples were often regarded as gangsters. He often told those He healed not to tell others (Luk.8:56). Unlike the movies, Jesus was not charming or good looking at all (Is.52:14). Christianity does not appear attractive to the casual observer.

The Bible is written in such a way that it appears like fairy tales to sceptics. Many concepts were explained through parables so that the meanings will not be apparent to many (Luk.8:10). To outsiders it appears that "Jesus could not save himself from the cross and that His followers are a bunch of bunglers and life is no better for them. Like all other religions they also have a number of commandments they have to adhere to".

It is only when we start investigating that the amazing miracle starts to become apparent. Our lives here may not improve visibly if we accept Jesus, in fact it usually appears to be worse. If it did improve noticeably it would attract insincere followers.

God is not trying to win a popularity poll or an election. If we have failed to notice or react to His magnificent creation and His great love for us, then many miracles would not either! He simply knocks on our door (Rev.3:20) (perhaps as you are reading here), and is hoping that you will open up your life to Him.

God want's us all to come to Him and to be in His Kingdom for ever. But He is testing us to see if we love Him in return and if we are sincere. He even created Satan and allows him to draw ignorant people away so that we have to make an effort to be with Him. We have to want to be with Him, and show it!

God Encourages Us.

God has planted the seed of knowledge of His existence within us, that instinctive feeling of 'longing for someone you have not met yet'. And that is exactly what it is! We were made to be with Him and we are unfulfilled if He is not in our lives! This need to fill the void within us exists in all human beings of all races, but in no other creatures because it is only relevant to humans! (another nail in the coffin of the theory of evolution!).

This is what makes all peoples on earth serve some god or other. The Incas, Egyptians, Greeks and Africans had numerous gods. They are all trying to find the true God but many have been led astray by the lies of Satan, and others have not heard the Good News! Unfortunately so many people accept anything that 'feels right' to them in order to fill this void. And then they stop searching. God has promised us that "Those who seek, will find". God has given us the Bible which is the only means by which God reveals Himself to us (2Tim.3:16, Rom.1:16). The Bible can be proven true in a court of law (Josh McDowell)!

The Holy Spirit works within us to help us understand the Gospel and to accept it. He encourages and consoles us. He is saddened by those who do not accept Him.

God uses His followers to tell and explain the Gospel to everyone who wants to hear. This is extremely important and we only have this life to do it in. Once we die, become senile or when Jesus returns our fate is sealed.

Faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see (Heb.11:1). If we really believe in Jesus and we love Him, we will get involved with Him and his church on earth.

Why so many Hardships

So often we hear people complaining that there are so many undeserved hardships in life. God does not make bad things happen to us but Satan does, but only as often and as badly as God allows. God continuously shields us from satan's attacks,

but once in a while He may allow Satan to hurt us for various reasons, but rarely as punishment.

We often dread hardships we expect to endure in the near future, and then we usually pray intensely to let it pass us by. But even if God saves us from of these hardships, we forget quickly and fail to thank and praise Him for it! We even say that our "good luck" saved us, or; "as luck would have it......"!

We cannot abide by the Ten Commandments, and all too often our hardships are a direct result of this. We deserve to get the fruits of our evil ways and very often our pains are as a direct result of wrongs that we have done!

Our hardships are not necessarily punishment for our deeds, but is often used as a wake-up call, to draw us closer to Him. Hardships build character, which is more important to God than our comfort now. (John 17:24). It is also a small contribution we make towards the birth pains of eternal life with God. We are fighting the same enemy!

The second most important command is that we should "love each other as ourselves". By this command God wants us to look after each other and thereby ease each other's pains and burdens.

However, it is good to know that we will not be tested beyond our abilities, and that we are on the winning side!

God has already proved several times that He loves each and everyone of us very much. His Son, Jesus, has sacrificed willingly and dearly to make it possible for us to share His perfect and everlasting kingdom with Him.

The Bible is a collection of 66 scriptures written by about 40 different authors. More than 239 events that are described in one book also appear or are referred to in one or more other books written by another author, thereby forming one cohesive and credible collection of books. The ancient dead sea scrolls found only a few decades ago is copy of the Bible; evidence that no corruption has occurred over time as some claim!

The Bible books have been written over a period of about 1600 years (that is about 50 generations!). Most if not all of these books have been written in two or more languages and all the *original* languages are used for our translations today! This is done by scores of translators from several church denominations. Translations are updated from time to time from the original languages to keep in pace with the changes in *our* languages. It is therefore likely to become even more accurate with every new translation. See the preface in your Bible.

Many attempts have been made to disprove the Bible. It would make front-page news if anyone did! In the process many became convinced that the Bible is trustworthy and can even be proven *true* in a court of law! People like Josh McDowell, an aspirant lawyer, came to this conclusion as described in his book "(New) Evidence that demands a verdict".

The Bible's account of origins is a framework through which we can explain everything about the world and life, and even the spiritual world! It is true to life and many events, many of which

are only occurring now in our times, have been described in it centuries ago. It foretold events such as space travel, pollution, tsunamis, earthquakes, uprisings, revolutions, and many more (Luke 21..). Many of these could not have been understood by the authors at the time and this proves that it has truly been inspired by God.

The earth is slowing down and losing it's magnetic field and the moon is slowly moving away from it. Jupiter's rings are unstable and like comets they are losing mass. Mountains are eroding, the sea is becoming more saline, deserts have been growing for centuries and human populations are increasing.
